



Dear Prospective Vendor,

The 4th annual Uwharrie Mountain Festival will be held at King's Mountain Point in the Uwharrie National Forest, Saturday, October 10, 2009. The festival is held, rain or shine, in an open field surrounded by a wooded recreation area on Badin Lake.

The mission of the festival is to showcase the natural resources, heritage and outdoor recreation opportunities of the Uwharrie Mountains. Toward that end, we are seeking vendors with merchandise that is largely handcrafted, may consist of local materials, and is created in the region.

**HOURS/SETUP:** The festival will be open to the public, 10am-5pm. Vendors may arrive on site between 6-8am to set up. Setup must be complete by 9 a.m. Each vendor is responsible for equipment, including tables, chairs, tents, etc. All vendor spaces will be 10 X 15'. Due to the primitive nature of the festival location, electricity is not provided. If your equipment, merchandise, or canopy will not fit within this space, you will need to reserve an additional space. Vehicles, including trailers that are not a direct part of a display, cannot be parked within the reserved vendor space. Parking is limited – please drive only what is necessary to transport your merchandise and setup.

**FEES:** The fee for the 10 X 15 vendor space is \$30. Checks should be made payable to: Uwharrie Mountain Festival. Before vendors depart the Festival, the U.S. Forest Service requires payment of 3% of your day's gross sales if you are a for-profit entity. Those checks may be made payable to the U.S. Forest Service.
